The classes required to complete the CPT Certificate are:

**MT 151 – Machine Shop Math**

Passing the KC Assessment Test required

**MT 215 – Manufacturing Processes 1**

Passing the MSSC Assessment Test required

**MT 283 – Manufacturing Technology Internship**

225 hours of On-The-Job Training
